PROJECT OVERVIEW

A Creative Cluster of Loft Studios @ VTOC Level 6

We are embarking on a mission to refurbish 3 studio apartments, transforming them from uninhabitable spaces into vibrant, functional living areas. This collaboration between the Youth Wing of YWCA Kuala Lumpur and Ai-Ling Ferges, aims to equip young women with practical DIY skills, boost their confidence, and provide opportunities to generate additional income.

The project comprises a series of DIY workshops by specialized volunteers, training a group of underprivileged young women from the YWCA Vocational Training Opportunity Centre (VTOC) towards refurbishing a number of damaged loft units at the VTOC Hostel.

Youth Wing is a group of creatives who uplift youth, particularly underprivileged young women from the YWCA Vocational Training Opportunity Centre (VTOC) through upcycling projects, skills-building, and social enterprise. The VTOC is a project of the YWCA of Kuala Lumpur. Established in 1998, it provides vocational skills training for young women and girls from the economically disadvantaged sectors of our community, irrespective of ethnicity, religion, social and cultural differences.

From 1998 to 2024 the VTOC has trained over 1,800 young women in the following courses:

- Early Childhood Education
- Fashion & Tailoring
- Culinary & Bakery
- Health Care
- Hairdressing & Beauty Care

The VTOC provides holistic development for the trainees through training in areas such as entrepreneurship, financial literacy, health, creativity and self-determination.




BE A DIY TRAINER OR VOLUNTEER

SIGN UP AS A VOLUNTEER OR WORKSHOP LEADER!

We are also in need of skilled professionals and volunteers to help guide and execute the renovation, as well as hold workshops to teach practical skills to the students.

Experts:

- Contractor: To oversee the project
- Plumber: For water supply and waste systems
- Electrical Foreman: For electrical installations and repairs
- Tile Laying Experts: For precise tile work
- Carpenter: For constructing and repairing wooden structures

General Volunteers:

- Assist with cleaning, demolition (hacking), and installation tasks
- Conduct workshops to teach practical skills to students

Workshop Leaders:

 Businesses or individuals to hold workshops for students, covering topics such as DIY skills, building maintenance skills, business skills, and personal development

WORKSHOP TOPICS

1. Introduction to DIY Skills and Safety

- Objective: Familiarize students with basic tools and safety practices
- Duration: 1-2 hours
- Introduction to basic tools, safety measures, proper handling techniques

2. Home Maintenance Basics

- Objective: Teach basic home maintenance tasks
- Duration: 2-3 hours
- Basic plumbing (fixing leaks), simple electrical repairs (replacing light bulbs), mold removal techniques

3. Tiling and Flooring

- Objective: Equip students with basic tiling and flooring skills
- Duration: 2-4 hours
- How to lay tiles, repair flooring, and use tiling tools

4. Painting and Decorating

- Objective: Teach painting and decorating techniques
- Duration: 2-3 hours
- Surface preparation, choosing paints, applying paint, basic decorating tips

5. Furniture Refurbishing

- Objective: Show how to refurbish and upcycle furniture
- Duration: 2-4 hours
- Sanding, painting, reupholstery, upcycling techniques

6. Project Planning and Management

- Objective: Teach project planning and management skills
- Duration: 1-2 hours
- Time management, resource allocation, project tracking

7. Advanced Carpentry

- Objective: Provide advanced carpentry skills
- Duration: 3–4 hours
- Building and repairing wooden structures, safe use of power tools

8. Motivational and Empowerment

- Objective: Build confidence & self-reliance
- Duration: 1-2 hours
- Content: Motivational talks, exploring career pathways, success stories, and benefits of completing DIY projects

PROJECT TIMELINE

Phase 1: Planning and Engagement (Sept - Nov 2024)

Finalize proposal, draft design, and fundraising plan Secure approvals, engage stakeholders, and start fundraising Raise RM 12,000 to RM 15,000 per studio for materials, etc. Promote through YWCA channels and networks

Phase 2: Preparation and Education (Nov - Jan 2025)

Finalize partnerships, purchase materials, schedule workshops Begin cleanup and foundational workshops with students and volunteers

Phase 3: Renovation and Learning (Jan 2025 - Jun 2025)

Conduct workshops and renovation in stages Apply and refine skills in practical tasks

Phase 4: Completion and Evaluation (Jun - Jul 2025)

Finish renovations, prepare rentals Host showcase event, evaluate impact

Phase 5: Reflection and Future Planning (mid of July 2025)

Collect feedback, analyze performance, plan future projects
